How to Make the Covers:

1. Print pages 2, 3, 4, and 5.
2. Color the house any way you wish. You may use markers, crayons, colored pencils or paint. Do not color a dark background because the cancel won't show.
3. Address each cover and affix a stamp.
4. Cut out the covers on the solid lines.
5. Fold on the dotted lines.
6. Put a small amount of glue on the two side flaps.
7. Step back and admire your masterpieces!

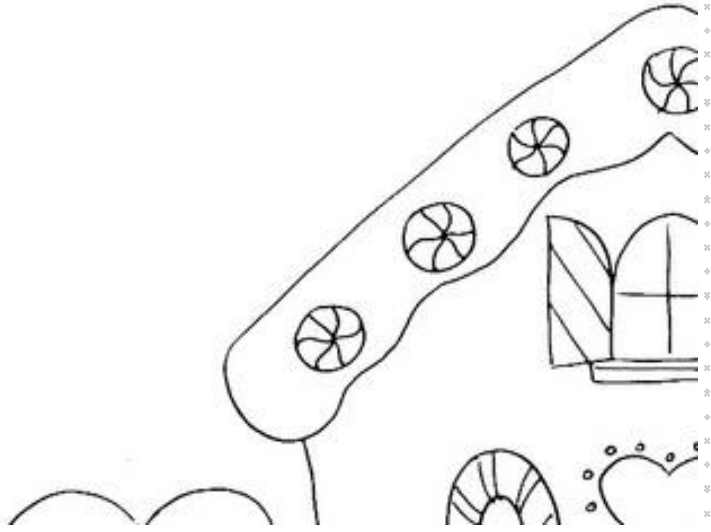
How to Order the First-Day-of-Issue Postmark:

1. You have 60 days to obtain the first-day-of-issue postmark by mail. All orders must be postmarked by January 6, 2014.
2. You should affix the stamps, address the envelopes (to yourself or others), and place them in a larger envelope addressed to:

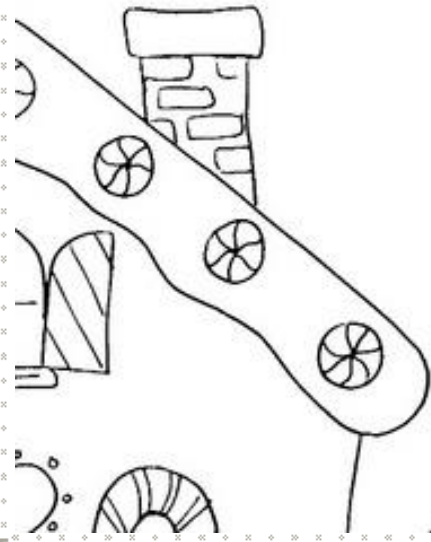

3. After applying the first-day-of-issue postmark, the Postal Service will return the envelopes through the mail. If you do not want your covers to go through the mail, include a self-addressed stamped envelope with enough postage on it to cover the weight of four covers.

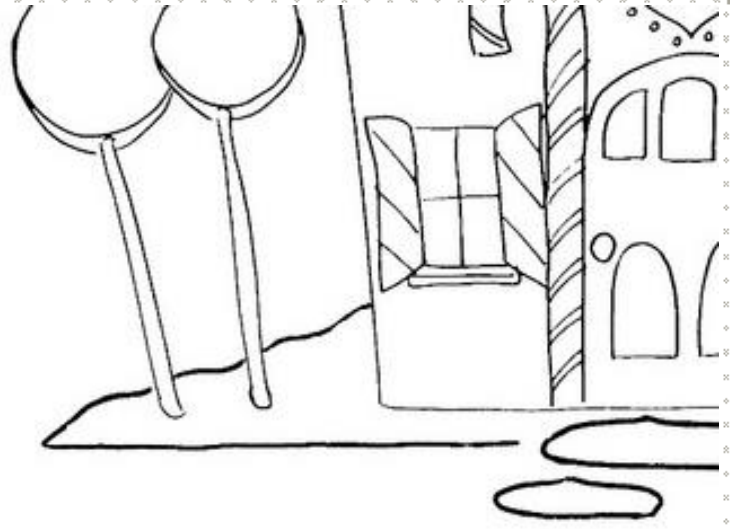
